This report documents the draft revised forecast of 2011 and 2012 peak demand that the Energy Commission recommends the California Independent System Operator use for its 2012 local area capacity requirements (LCR) study. The LCR study determines the total local area capacity to be allocated to load-serving entities as part of their year-ahead local resource adequacy requirement.

The Energy Commission requests comments on the draft 2011 and 2012 peak demand forecast by January 13, 2011.
